

SOME TOXIC PLANTS TO WATCH FOR



SAGO PALM – Every part of this commonly seen landscaping plant is **TOXIC** and can **KILL** your pet within hours. Especially the seeds.



FOXGLOVE – Also known as digitalis. Affects the heart and can cause death. Trumpet shaped flowers clustered on stalks up to 4 feet or more!



GERANIUMS – Common garden flowers that come in many varieties. Ruffled lily-petal shaped leaves in solid or variegated greens. Cluster flowers in solids or fancy varieties. Outdoor plants, potted or in ground.



POINSETTIAS – Not just a toxic holiday plant, these can grow in yards year round, look much different, can grow to **HUGE** heights, and they aren't always red.



FIRESTICK CACTUS – This plant is awful. Also called sticks on fire, pencil cactus, euphorbia tirucalli. Milky white sap is toxic to humans, dogs and cats. Can cause serious intestinal and skin injury and even death. Color varies from green to orange/yellow/red throughout year.

PEACE LILY –
Or Spathiphyllum.
Common INDOOR
house plant.

CALLA LILY –
Very common wedding
flower, grown indoor or
outdoors and
no longer just
white with
solid green
leaves.



WISTERIA –
An (invasive)
outdoor plant with
white, pink or
purple flower
clusters. Can be a
climbing vine or
tree with one or
several trunks.



DAFFODILS –
Or narcissus, popular
spring bulb. Outdoors
or can be forced inside
for Easter etc.
Comes in lots of
colors, sizes and
proportions.



CLEMATIS –
An outdoor climbing vine with
big flowers in many colors and
patterns. **PASSION FLOWERS** too.



HIBISCUS –
If you don't know this
plant, check the back of
someone's car. Common
outdoor shrub or
tree, potted or in
ground. Can be
huge shrubs with different
flowers in many colors.

SOME TOXIC PLANTS TO WATCH FOR



AZALEA –
A common flowering shrub or small tree of many colors grown IN or OUT in shade, although some varieties more are sun tolerant now.



CYCLAMEN –
Pretty flowers in many colors with variegated or solid green leaves. Grown indoors or shaded outdoors.



MISTLETOE –
Not just seen at Xmas. This is a parasitic plant so more likely to be found growing IN/ON a host plant/tree.



OLEANDER –
VERY common shrub often grown to HUGE sizes and used as privacy hedging. Flowers in several colors, often seen in freeway center dividers. Highly TOXIC.



MOST IVY –
Common indoor or outdoor plant in solid or variegated green leaves.

PATHOS –
Common INDOOR plant in solid or variegated green leaves.
